

PROMET U ZRAČNIM LUKAMA U RUJNU 2021. TRAFFIC IN AIRPORTS SEPTEMBER 2021

U rujnu 2021. ukupan promet putnika u hrvatskim zračnim lukama iznosio je 912 tisuća ili 336,0% više nego u rujnu 2020., kada je ostvaren promet od samo 209 tisuća putnika zbog širenja bolesti COVID-19. Za usporedbu, u rujnu 2019. ostvaren je promet od 1 494 tisuće putnika. U rujnu 2021. ostvareno je 61,0% prometa putnika iz rujna 2019.

Najveći promet putnika ostvarila je zračna luka Split, s 326 tisuća putnika, što je više za 337,2% u odnosu na rujan 2020., kada je prevezeno 75 tisuća putnika (u rujnu 2019. prevezeno je 468 tisuća putnika), slijedi zračna luka Dubrovnik, s 207 tisuća putnika (u rujnu 2020. prevezeno je 39 tisuća putnika, dok su u rujnu 2019. prevezene 403 tisuće putnika) te zračna luka Zagreb, sa 189 tisuća putnika (u rujnu 2020. prevezeno je 65 tisuća putnika, dok je u rujnu 2019. prevezeno 348 tisuća putnika).

Najznačajniji međunarodni putnički promet ostvaren je sa zračnim lukama Njemačke, 203 tisuće putnika, što je porast od 296,7% u odnosu na isto razdoblje 2020., kada je prevezena 51 tisuća putnika.

Ukupan broj slijetanja i polijetanja zrakoplova u zračnim lukama u rujnu 2021. iznosio je 13 270, što je porast od 99,7% u usporedbi s rujnom 2020., kada je broj slijetanja i polijetanja iznosio samo 6 645. Ukupan broj slijetanja i polijetanja zrakoplova u zračnim lukama u rujnu 2019. iznosio je 15 272.

Ukupan promet tereta u zračnim lukama u rujnu 2021. iznosio je 849 tona, što je porast od 28,1% u usporedbi s rujnom 2020., kada je promet tereta iznosio 663 tone.

The total traffic of passengers in Croatian airports amounted to 912 thousand in September 2021, which was 336.0% more than in September 2020, when the total traffic of passengers amounted to only 209 thousand, due to the spread of the COVID-19 disease. By comparison, in September 2019, the total traffic of passengers amounted to 1 494 thousand. The total traffic of passengers in September 2021 accounted for 61.0% of the total traffic of passengers realised in September 2019.


The largest traffic of passengers was recorded in the Split Airport, with 326 thousand passengers, which was an increase of 337.2% compared to September 2020, when the traffic of passengers amounted to 75 thousand (the traffic of passengers amounted to 468 thousand in September 2019). The Dubrovnik Airport followed, with 207 thousand passengers (the traffic of passengers amounted to 39 thousand in September 2020 and to 403 thousand in September 2019) and the Zagreb Airport, with 189 thousand passengers (the traffic of passengers amounted to 65 thousand in September 2020 and to 348 thousand in September 2019).

The most significant international traffic of passengers was realised with German airports, 203 thousand passengers, which was an increase of 296.7% compared to the same period of 2020, when the traffic of passengers amounted to 51 thousand.

The total number of landings and take-offs in airports in September 2021 amounted to 13 270 movements, which was 99.7% more than in September 2020, when the total number of landings and take-offs in airports amounted to only 6 645 movements. The total number of landings and take-offs in airports amounted to 15 272 movements in September 2019.

The total traffic of freight in airports in September 2021 amounted to 849 tonnes, which was an increase of 28.1% compared to September 2020, when the total traffic of freight in airports amounted to 663 tonnes.

METODOLOŠKA OBJAŠNJENJA

Izvori i metode prikupljanja podataka

Kumulativni podatak nije uvijek jednak zbroju pojedinačnih mjesecnih rezultata zbog zaokruživanja na tisuće.

Svrha istraživanja jest prikupiti podatke o broju svih operacija zrakoplova, prometu putnika i tereta na komercijalnim operacijama u zračnim lukama te u pristaništima Republike Hrvatske.

Jedinice promatranja i izvještajne jedinice jesu zračne luke u Republici Hrvatskoj. Podaci su prikupljeni u obliku elektroničkih setova i na obrascu PZ/M-21.

Obuhvat

Podaci o zračnom prometu (ukupne operacije zrakoplova, promet putnika i tereta u zračnim lukama) odnose se na rad zračnih luka Zagreb, Split, Dubrovnik, Pula, Rijeka, Zadar, Osijek, Brač te zračnog pristaništa Mali Lošinj.

NOTES ON METHODOLOGY

Sources and methods of data collection

Cumulative data are not always equal to the sum of individual monthly results due to the rounding of numbers to the nearest thousand.

The purpose of the survey is to collect data on the number of all aircraft movements and the traffic of passengers and freight on commercial operations in airports and air landing places of the Republic of Croatia.

The observation units and reporting units are airports in the Republic of Croatia. Data are collected in the form of electronic datasets and on the PZ/M-21 form.

Coverage

The data on air traffic (total aircraft movements, traffic of passengers and freight in airports) relate to the activities of the airports of Zagreb, Split, Dubrovnik, Pula, Rijeka, Zadar, Osijek, Brač and the air landing place of Mali Lošinj.

Broj ukupnih operacija zrakoplova u zračnim lukama odnosi se na broj svih (komercijalnih i nekomercijalnih) operacija slijetanja i polijetanja zrakoplova, osim državnih letova (vojska, carina, policija).

Promet putnika u zračnim lukama obuhvaća broj otpočivalih i doputovalih putnika na komercijalnim operacijama. Isključeni su putnici u direktnom tranzitu. Putnici u direktnom tranzitu jesu putnici koji, nakon kratkog zaustavljanja, nastavljaju svoje putovanje istim zrakoplovom na letu s istim brojem leta kao let s kojega su stigli.

Promet tereta u zračnim lukama odnosi se na utovarenu i istovarenu robu i poštu na komercijalnim operacijama, osim prtljage putnika. Isključen je teret u direktnom tranzitu.

The number of total aircraft movements in airports refers to the number of all (commercial and non-commercial) operations of landing and taking-off of an aircraft, except state flights (military, customs, police).

Traffic of passengers in airports includes the number of passengers who have departed or arrived on commercial operations. Passengers in direct transit are excluded. Direct transit passengers are passengers who, after a short stop, continue their journey on the same aircraft on a flight having the same flight number as the flight on which they arrived.

Traffic of freight in airports refers to the loaded and unloaded goods and mail on commercial operations other than the baggage of passengers. The freight in direct transit is excluded.
