FIRST QUARTERLY GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT ESTIMATE, FOURTH QUARTER OF 2022

The estimation of the gross domestic product (GDP) for the fourth quarter of 2022 is presented by major categories of expenditure and according to the NKD 2007. activity sections.

The quarterly GDP data focus on short-term movements of the economy, while the main purpose of the quarterly GDP estimate is the calculation of real growth rates.

The estimate shows that the quarterly GDP in real terms increased by 4.0% in the fourth quarter of 2022, as compared to the same quarter of 2021.

Seasonally adjusted quarterly GDP increased by 0.9% compared to the previous quarter and also increased by 4.2% in real terms compared to the same quarter of 2021.

The first estimate shows that the GDP in real terms increased by 6.3% in 2022, as compared to 2021.

A real growth is visible in all of the GDP categories on the expenditure side.

The first estimate shows that the quarterly GVA increased in real terms by 3.1% in the fourth quarter of 2022, as compared to the same quarter of 2021, based on nonadjusted data.

The increase in GVA was influenced by a significant increase in real value added in the activity Wholesale and retail trade, transportation, storage, accommodation and food service activities.

In Statistics in Line, the data by major categories of expenditure and according to the NKD 2007. activity sections at current prices, constant prices of the previous year, constant prices of the reference year (2015 = 100) and real growth rates are presented.
